## Ballet Arizona's *Ballet Under the Stars* Receives Significant Municipal and Local Support

**Phoenix, AZ** – This September 20 – 29, <u>Ballet Arizona</u> presents the 15<sup>th</sup> annual <u>Ballet Under the Stars</u>. "Instead of attendees sitting quietly in rows of seats in Symphony Hall, they can bring a blanket or a lawn chair and relax under the nighttime

sky while watching a fully staged performance," says Richard Nilsen, *The Arizona Republic*.

"Ballet Under the Stars takes Ballet Arizona out of the studio and out of the theater. With the addition of the Class Act Residency that I coordinate, this program removes the barriers to engaging, relevant ballet performances and is truly a point of pride for the communities and corporations that host us," says Brenda Bernardi, Manager of Human Resources & Volunteer Services.

Ballet Arizona will offer a varied evening of dance with something for everyone. On the perform is the first movement from Ib Andersen's *Sueños*, George Balanchine's *Stravinksy Violin Concerto*, and a sneak peek of Balanchine's *Serenade*, which will be performed in its entirety later this season in May 2013.

In addition *Ballet Under the Stars* will feature a presentation of **Class Act**, one of Ballet Arizona's Education and Outreach programs. Class Act is a project combining the talents and expertise of the professional dancers of Ballet Arizona with the youthful ideas and creative energies of school-age children.

This September, participating schools include McDowell Mountain Elementary School, Clarendon Elementary School, Broadmore Kidzone, Don Mensendick Elementary School, and Evergreen Elementary Afterschool Program. Class Act ignites the children's creative spirit and positively increases their exposure to the performing arts.
