## **HEALTH & SAFETY MEASURES**

The health and safety of our patrons, employees and students is a priority for Ballet Arizona. We are committed to protecting everyone with protocols and practices that meet or exceed recommendations of local, state and federal government. Our efforts include ongoing work with medical professionals and other safety consultants to establish safety measures, social distancing practices and extensive cleaning protocols.

## Dorrance Theatre Performance Venue Safety Measures

**Cleaning:** Before and after each show, the theatre, lobby restrooms and other high-traffic areas are cleaned and sanitized according to current recommendations. Hand sanitizing stations will be available throughout the building.

**Masks:** All patrons are required to wear a mask at all times while in the building. Individuals who are unable to wear a mask for health reasons should choose to make arrangements to enjoy the programming made available for viewing at home.

Arrival: Ticketing and arrival will be touch free. Patrons will be asked to arrive within a certain window of time before the performance to allow for ample time for check-in and seating. Floor markings will be in place to allow patrons to practice social distancing during entry, seating, and departure.

**Seating:** Capacity in the Dorrance Theatre will be significantly reduced to allow for adequate social distancing of parties. All seating will be assigned by the Ballet Arizona box office to be sure that appropriate spacing is in place.

**Restrooms:** Restroom occupancy will be limited to two people at a time. Floor markings will assist with social distancing for those waiting to use the facility.

**During the show:** Each performance will run approximately no more than one hour and will not have an intermission. We will have restroom facilities available but they will be limited in number due to social distancing.

**Food and Beverage:** Refreshments will not be available in the lobby before or after the show.

**Departure:** To maintain social distancing, patrons will exit the theatre by individual rows rather than all at once. Usher will assist with this practice.

Your health and safety are deeply valued. We will continue to seek guidance from health professionals and enact any additional measures needed to ensure the highest standards of safety are met.
