## Children's Division (Ages 4-9)

## **Lower Division (Ages 9-14)**

Watch as your child progresses their dance skills with continued rigor and progression. Students enjoy two-and-a-half hours of training, five days per week. Classes consist of one-and-a-half hours of ballet technique and one hour of supplemental classes, including variations on conditioning, jazz, modern and musical theater. Classes are only \$450 for two weeks and \$900 for four weeks. A \$30 registration fee applies for both options.
