Experience brilliant special effects as the wonders of childhood come alive when Clara receives a magical nutcracker doll as a Christmas present, sending the little girl and her Nutcracker Prince on a wondrous and fascinating adventure of dancing toys, mischievous mice, a scary Mouse King, waltzing flowers, and sparkling snowflakes.

The \$1.8 million production was created in 2006 by Ballet Arizona Artistic Director Ib Andersen, and features the company's 30 professional dancers, more than 100 youth performers, 100,000 Swarovski crystals, 260 costumes created with 6,500 yards of tulle, and twenty-five different enchanting backdrops. It was named one of the top three productions in the United States by *The New York Times*' chief dance critic, Alastair Macaulay.
