I can bring things that help me feel comfortable, like headphones, fidgets, or a snack.


I can wear whatever I like, whether fancy, casual, or cozy, and maybe bring a sweater in case it is cool inside.



The Nutcracker will be performed at the Symphony Hall in Phoenix Arizona.




To get there, I will drive to the theater and park in a parking garage or on the street.







After parking in the Garage I will use an elevator or the stairs to get to the street.




Once I get to the street I will walk to Symphony Hall.

Before the show begins, someone will come on stage and tell me everything I need to know about The Nutcracker.




The show will be on the stage, I will see ballet dancers, lights and beautiful costumes.

This is all pretend, and the dancers are regular people dressing in costumes.


The music in the show might be to loud for me. It is okay for me to use my noise canceling headphones, or use my hands to cover my ears.
